Green Tech Recycling 205 W. Spring St., 507-344-1315

Open M-F, 9:00-5:00, year round. \$30 or \$50 for pick-up.

No charge for these items: Ni-CD (Cordless Drill, etc.), Li-Ion (Laptop, Cell Phone), Power Equipment, Oil & Gas MUST be drained, Lawn Mower, Weed Eater, Snow Blower, Chainsaws, Tapes, videos, CD's, plastic, glass, metal Doors, windows, bed foam

A fee for these items: *Appliances, *Electronics, incl. *computers, Bare/Broken CRT Tubes, Hard Drive Data Destruction, Fluorescent bulbs, , Alkaline Batteries regular or rechargeable. **They will pay you** for lead car/truck batteries.

*Thanks to a City of Mankato subsidy, you can drop-off electronics for free and appliances for \$8. Show your Mankato water bill.

S.S. Boutique non-profit—

Collects clothes, shoes, furniture, beds and home essentials for people transitioning from homelessness, any age from new born up, at no cost. Drop off shoes and small items at Bounce Town (across from River Hills Mall). For other items, call Brianna at 952-688-6623. You can volunteer to help fill orders, sort or deliver.

Plastic Bags - Recycle plastic grocery bags at grocery stores and most big box store entrances.

Tune Town—507-625-6507, 630 N. Riverfront Dr. accepts working record players recordings. Buys vinyl albums, DVD's, CDs, Blu Rays. Anything not sellable (i.e. cassette tapes) they recycle.

Shredded paper can be taken to N. Mankato Recycling Center but **not** to Blue Earth County Recycling Center. For info, go to www.mankatozerowaste.com. It can be recycled at Ponderosa Landfill or unbagged at **LJP Waste Recycling** - 625-1968, 2160 Ringhofer Drive, N. Mankato.

Best Buy, 1895 Adams St., 507-344-1001 Accepts all small electronics (no appliances), but, if you purchase an appliance from them and have it delivered, they will haul away and recycle old appliance for \$15. \$25 is charged for monitors and T.V.'s .(No console T.V.'s). Tube T.V.'s must be 32" or smaller. Flat screen T.V.'s are O.K. up to 50" In the entry way you can recycle cables, cords, wires, gift cards, plastic bags, and rechargeable batteries (1 battery / baggie) . Take ink cartridges & cell phones to customer service. Check with customer service for details on their trade-in program to get credit for gently used electronics.

SMILES holds an annual computer/electronic recycling event as a Fall fundraiser in the Madison East parking lot. They accept computers, monitors, printers, TVs, stereos, VCRs, DVD players, microwaves, air conditioners, dehumidifiers and mini refrigerators; charging 55 cents per pound.

MORE METAL/ALUMINUM RECYCLING - Mankato Iron and Metal, 215 West Elm, 625-6489, (will pay for aluminum cans); **BEI Metal**, 1205 Beaver Avenue, 507-625-1950; **Alter Metal Recycling**, 804 Industrial Road, 507-387-6504. No electronics but they do take electric motors and transformers with no PCB's. and switchboards
