Contact your legislator to support **HF 3200**, authored by Jordan, Edelson, Jordan, Feist and Stephenson establishing recycling refund program for beverage containers and bill **HF 1857** relating to commerce; prohibiting sale of water in plastic containers.

Contact your state representative to support an effective EPR Packaging Reduction and Recycling bill to hold producers responsible for recycling their products, redesigning them to be sustainable in packaging and banning toxic chemicals from products following the 10 principles outlined by Beyond Plastics.

Contact your state legislators to support Zero Waste Grant Program **HF2693/SF2901**. This grant program would prioritize reduction and reuse and provide opportunity to build alternatives to the current linear consumption stream. It would help overcome start-up barriers and support efforts to create reuse and refill systems and help make products and packaging safer to use and better for the environment.
